

Regenerating the Economy: A Business Webinar on the New Malta Enterprise Schemes

On the 27th April 2021, a set of new measures and initiatives were announced by the Government to regenerate the Maltese economy. These included: (a) a renewed rent and electricity scheme; (b) a one-time grant for businesses that will remain closed after the 10th May 2021; (c) Change To Grow 2021; (d) Restart Incentive scheme 2021; (e) Smart and Sustainable Investment scheme 2021; and (f) Micro-Invest Tax Credit Extension. Kurt Farrugia, CEO of Malta Enterprise will provide an overview of the indicated initiatives.
